### Dr. Susan Bachrach

Curator of Special Exhibitions, United States Holocaust Memorial Museum. Susan Bachrach has worked on many exhibitions, including *Schindler; Liberation 1945; Nazi Olympics; Flight and Rescue; Deadly Medicine*; and most recently, *Some Were Neighbors*. Her publications include: *Tell Them We Remember*, the history of the Holocaust written for younger readers; and texts for *Deadly Medicine, Nazi Olympics; Berlin 1936*; and *Nazi Propaganda*. Dr. Bachrach first began working at the Museum in 1992 as a historian and writer for the *I.D. Card Project*.

Sam Chestnut has served as Head of School for The Lippman School and the Lillian and Betty Ratner School. He began his teaching career in Cuyahoga Valley National Park and then as an instructor of Mathematics and Jewish American History at Lippman.
